

Clematis 'Tye Dye'

Tie Dye Clematis



DESCRIPTION

The Tie Dye flower is similar to the popular 'Jackmanii', but the 4-6" flower have dark blue petals with lavender-white centers that streak out to the edges creating a splash of color on each bloom and has the look of tie dyed cloth.

Bloom from June through July.

Vine is rabbit and deer resistant

Roots must be kept cool.
