Rugosa Rose



DESCRIPTION

Rugosa or Beach roses are commonly found along many Rhode Island beaches and range across North America from Nova Scotia to Florida and along the Gulf coast. Blooming in the summer, the beach rose produces 2- to 4-inch pink/red flowers

The flowers of the rugosa rose bear fruit, called rose hips, which last through the summer and into the winter months. The fruit is orange to brick red and is eaten by many birds and other animals, including humans
